

Hand Plane Tune-up

This one day course is designed to teach basic hand plane skills. How do hand planes work? What are the reasons they do not work? These questions will be discussed and answered as you learn the correct way to diagnose and tune up your own hand planes. Learn the many different types of hand planes and how each is used and “Why are there so many? Isn’t one enough” (one is never enough). You will learn everything from how to flatten a board, four squaring a board, to removing machine marks and creating those nice crisp and detailed edges on your work quickly and efficiently. *This is a highly recommended class. You must take the Tool Sharpening Basics class first and come with your plane irons (blades) already sharpened.*

During this class, you will true-up, tune, adjust and use your own plane(s).
