

Wooden Pen Turning

This entry level wood lathe project will be a simple yet fun and interesting class. Students will learn basic lathe safety and operation, along with various tool use for gluing and clamping. Students will learn to properly size pen blanks along with drilling and setting up a mandrel. The wood lathe will be the main tool of use, but other tools will be used to achieve a final product which these skills can be used in other future projects around the shop!

Note: Safety glasses/face shield along with tight fitting clothes must be worn and long hair must be pulled back at all times.
